

Time	TODDLERS 13 MONTHS – 18 MONTHS
7:00	Greet children check for bruises etc. give them a hot bottle and let children go back to sleep
8:00	Pampers check
8:15	Free Play with soft toys
8:45	Pampers changing & hand washing
9:00	Story time (LANGUAGE DEVELOPMENT) We read to our babies often, study shows it help with their language development.
9:20	Snack time/bottle /juice /water/fruit/cookies
9:45	Outside play (Students will be engaged in large motor skills development) Hopping, skipping, jumping, balancing, climbing, swinging, catching a ball, throwing a ball and most of all running and screaming and having a grand time.
10:45	Language Development: M/W/F (students will be engaged in fine motor skills development) Poems & finger play, soap bubbles, play dough, ball pits, and story book will be read to students. A minimum of 2 stories per day. DISNEY SING ALONG SONGS : T/TH
11:00	Diaper change and hand washing
11:20	Lunch time
11:55	Bath time
12:40	Nap time Teachers prepare students bags for dismissal after taking out their final snacks and placing washed containers and students personal items in.
2:40	Diaper changing and hand washing
3:10	Snack time
3:30	Prepare children for dismissal (ensure all faces are cleaned and lotion, laces tied, hair fixed)
3:45	Story time (at least 2 books)
4:00	Diaper changing & hand washing
4:30	Free play and educational videos only
5 – 6	Clean work area, wash and sterilize toys, and prepare class for next day

ALL STUDENTS ARE ASSIGNED A SLEEP COT UPON REGISTERING. THAT COT WILL BE LABELLED WITH YOUR CHILDS NAME. WHEN STUDENTS LIE DOWN TO SLEEP DURING NAP TIME. THEY WILL LIE HEAD TO TAIL AND NOT HEAD TO HEAD. THIS WILL HELP PREVENT ANY CONTACTS BETWEEN STUDENTS DURING QUIET TIME.
